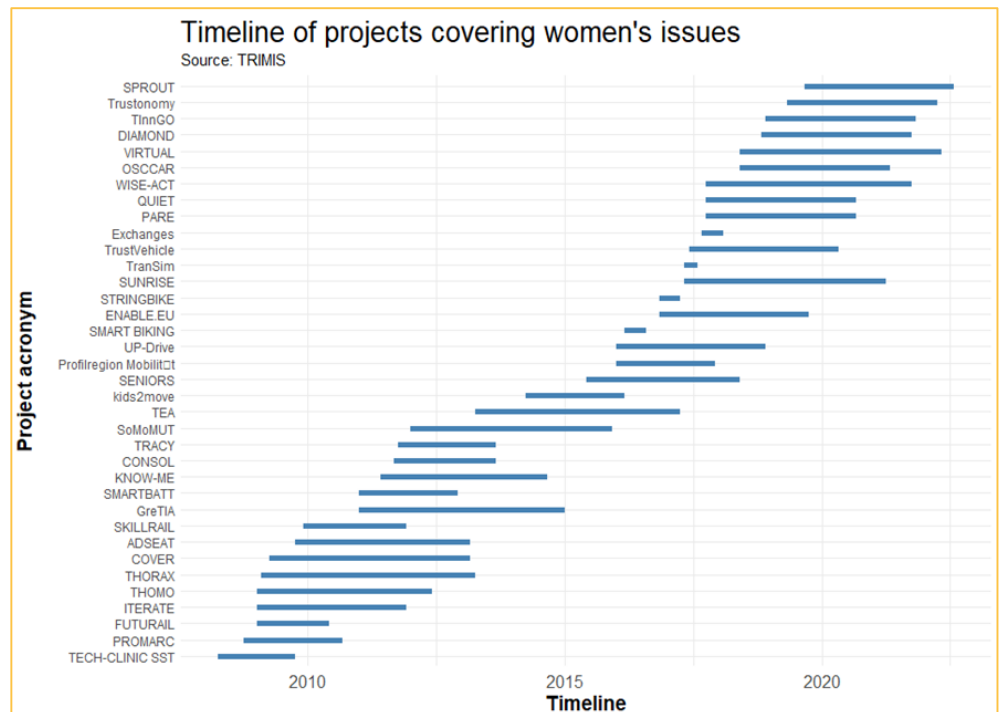

The TRIMIS database includes several projects that cover women's issues in transport (keywords used include 'female', 'women' and 'gender'). Most projects have women as a (sub) research topic, for instance by describing the different impacts of transport innovation on men and women. Other projects do not research women's issues, but aim to involve women researchers in the project. Finally, some projects focus solely on women's issues in transport (e.g. the TinnGO project).
