AIM OF THE GUIDANCE

The aim of this guidance is to provide you with clear indications on how to update the existing information contained in the Country Profile for the Member State you are representing.

This is a unique opportunity for you to disseminate and promote transport R&I information, material and data for your member state through the TRIMIS website providing a trusted reference point freely accessible to stakeholders.


Setting up EU login account


Please follow the three steps below in order to be able to insert information on the TRIMIS website.

1. Access the TRIMIS website on <https://trimis.ec.europa.eu/>
2. Set up an EU login account by following the following instructions https://webgate.ec.europa.eu/tracesnt-help/Content/C_EU%20login/create-a-new-EU-login-account.htm
3. Send an e-mail to the TRIMIS account (trimis@ricardo.com) with your EU Login account and e-mail and country profile that you would like to update, in order to be provided with the correct permissions to update information on the country profile. If you need further support with this, then please get in contact.

Relevant buttons/links have been circled in **green** in the below screenshots.

Update the country profiles through the website by selecting the caption “Policies & Funding”, “EU Member States” or “Other countries” and clicking on the relevant country.





Insert/update the information available in the following fields:

Policy Background: (MANDATORY) Insert a description of the governmental programmes that define the objectives of the national research and innovation agenda. In addition, insert specific information on transport research and innovation. Please provide links to the specific laws, regulations, and policy documents.

Institutional framework of transport research: (MANDATORY) Insert and describe the organisations responsible for research and innovation activities in your Member State, inserting links to relevant organisation websites. Please provide links to the specific institutions.

Funding Sources and Support Initiatives: (MANDATORY) Insert the title of any thematic programme or funding research on transport related topics and, if available, the website link.

Official Documents: Insert the requested information about official documents (e.g. law, legislative decree, regulations, etc.) that establish the background for transport research and innovation in your Member State.

Research Documents: List any relevant national transport research studies, reports and analyses undertaken in the last three years that could be included on the TRIMIS website. If you have documents in digital form, please upload those.

Thematic areas/topics: Insert the priority focus areas/topics for strategic transport research and innovation. (E.g. Intelligent transport systems, High-tech materials, Environment, infrastructures, etc.) Also include the key users of knowledge.

When attaching material, please provide it in English, or if the original document is only available in another language, upload an English summary of the content.

Once completed, please click on preview at the top of the page to double check the country overview update. Set the status to “First review” and then select “Save” to send to the TRIMIS team for review.
