Upgrade and construction of second track on the Križevci-Koprivnica-state border railway line section

Mediterranean Corridor



The Action covers the upgrading of the existing track and the construction of a new second track of the 43.2 km long Križevci-Koprivnica-Hungarian state border railway section. The Action is located on the Mediterranean Corridor and it is part of a global project covering the modernisation of the Zagreb-Hungarian state border railway line.

The Action consists of four activities:

- construction works
- engineering supervision
- project management
- land acquisition

Once completed, the Action will have a positive impact on traffic management, modal split, congestion, inter-operability, service quality, safety and security, and on environment by shifting traffic from road to rail.
