## Construction of the Svilaj Bridge across Sava river on the border between the Republic of Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina

Rhine-Danube corridor



The Sava river marks part of the border between Croatia and Bosnia and Herzegovina. The Action aims at removing a major road bottleneck between the two countries by constructing a 660 meter long bridge across the Sava river, in Svilaj, on the Rhine-Danube Corridor. The Action is part of a global project covering the whole cross-border section of motorway A5 from Sredanci Interchange in Croatia to Odžak in Bosnia and Herzegovina.

The Action consists of two activities:

- Project management, including communication and visibility, and
- Bridge construction of the Croatian part.

Once completed, the Action will have a positive socio-economic impact in terms of reduction in travel time and vehicle operating costs and enhancement of the economic competitiveness of the concerned regions.
